BWC Safety Incentive Program Enrollment Period Begins Save 4% on Your Workers' Comp Premiums!

The Dayton Miami Valley Safety Council would like to invite you to enroll in the FY011 4% Incentive Program before July 31st, 2010. Companies who participate in this program will receive up to 4% rebate on their workers' compensations premiums. To earn this rebate, companies must enroll in the Dayton/Miami Valley Safety Council and complete appropriate paperwork by July 31, 2010 and begin working toward the requirements established by the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation.
