Safety Council members also have access to various technical, legal, educational, legislative, and regulatory resources. Governance & Current Leadership

The Safety Council is guided by a volunteer Board that meets quarterly. The Board is led by Chair, Connie Muncy of Montgomery County Water Services. There are currently more than 350 members of the Safety Council.

Events & Programs

The Safety Council hosts the following educational programs during the year:

- **Safety Breakfast with the Experts series** – This monthly breakfast series features presentations from local experts on a wide variety of safety topics and is held on the third Wednesday of the month. - **Safety Conference & Symposium** – This annual conference features a full day of seminars, presentations, and exhibitors on a wide array of safety topics.
- **Hot Topics** – The Safety Council hosts periodic "Hot Topics," in-depth discussions (typically 2-4 hours in length) on emerging safety trends. These programs are typically held in response to recent state and/or federal regulatory activity.
- **10-Hour OSHA Course** – Safety Council members have the option to attend or send colleagues to 10-hour OSHA training courses that are provided at reduced rates to members.
